- Decolonial ethos: CEL-MP disrupts traditional hierarchies by positioning young Africans not as passive beneficiaries, but as colleagues and decisionmakers.
- Practical empowerment:
 Fellows gain not just knowledge,
 but real leadership experience
 with responsibilities,
 deliverables, and visibility.
- Remote inclusivity:

 Participants may work from their home countries, strengthening local ecosystems and reducing pressures of migration.
- Sustainability: Graduates become part of a growing alumni network that feeds back into Africa's evidence-to-policy community.

The Corporate Evidence Leader
Mentorship Programme (CEL-MP) is
PACKS Africa's flagship initiative
designed to empower young Africans
to take leadership roles within the
continent's evidence ecosystems.
Unlike conventional capacity-building
programmes that end with training,
CEL-MP ensures a full transition from
learning to practice.

Phase 1 (12 months)

Structured theoretical sessions on leadership and technical competencies in Evidence-Informed Decision-Making (EIDM).

Phase 2 (12 months)

Hands-on practice, where participants assume official organisational roles within PACKS Africa, working directly on projects across Africa.



- Africa has the youngest population in the world, but young people remain underrepresented in evidence and policy leadership spaces.
- Most capacity initiatives stop at training; CEL-MP goes further by ensuring mentees become practitioners and leaders.
- By building African-led, contextsensitive leadership, CEL-MP strengthens governance, accountability, and the sustainability of evidence use.

- Fellows are contributing to realworld projects in evidence use, policy engagement, and organisational development.
